It manages many activities addressing and fostering the term of sustainability.</p> <p>Sport Committee: organizing and encouraging sports activities.</p> <p>Cultural Committee: organizing various cultural activities to develop awareness of the UAE cultural issues.</p> <p>Public Relation and Media Committee: organize various media activities and develop public relations.</p> <p>Arts Committee: organizing artistic activities that highlight students' talents.</p> <p>Public Services Committee: participating in public service projects and volunteer activities to serve the environment and society.</p> <p>Social Activities and Trips Committee: organizing trips, social and cultural events.</p> <p>Scientific and Technological Activities Committee: holding seminars and lectures aimed at developing scientific and technological awareness.</p>

In addition, it helps to enhance individual and group talents that contribute in the formation of the general culture and the development of thought.</p>

Statement	<p>The student council is committed to be the students' representative during their study</p>		
Procedures	<p>Note: The Council establishment, its objectives and terms of reference are set, its membership, subcommittees and dates are implemented in accordance to the stipulated in the Ministerial Decree No. (334) of 2011.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • The student council consists of (15) members. One third of its members are elected while two thirds are appointed to ensure that all colleges are represented in the Council, provided that the number of Council representatives from each college does not exceed (3). • The membership of the student Council is subject to the following: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ◦ To be a regular, full time student. ◦ To hold a good reputation. ◦ The student's record must be lacking any penalties or disciplinary warnings. 		

	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ◦ The student must have a clear criminal record. <p>Tasks of the Student Council:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Developing, reviewing and amending the bylaws of the Council in coordination with the University Administration represented by a Deanship of students Affairs. • Coordinate the work of the committees of the Council, adopt its work programs and follow up their implementation. • Monitor the work of the committees of the Council and their compliance with the terms and conditions of the Council, as well as gain approvals and necessary permits. • Set the annual budget of the Council and its committees and distributing the financial appropriations to the committees. • Approve the final budget of the Council. • Submit periodic reports on the work of the Council to the university administration represented by the Deanship of Student Affair.
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
